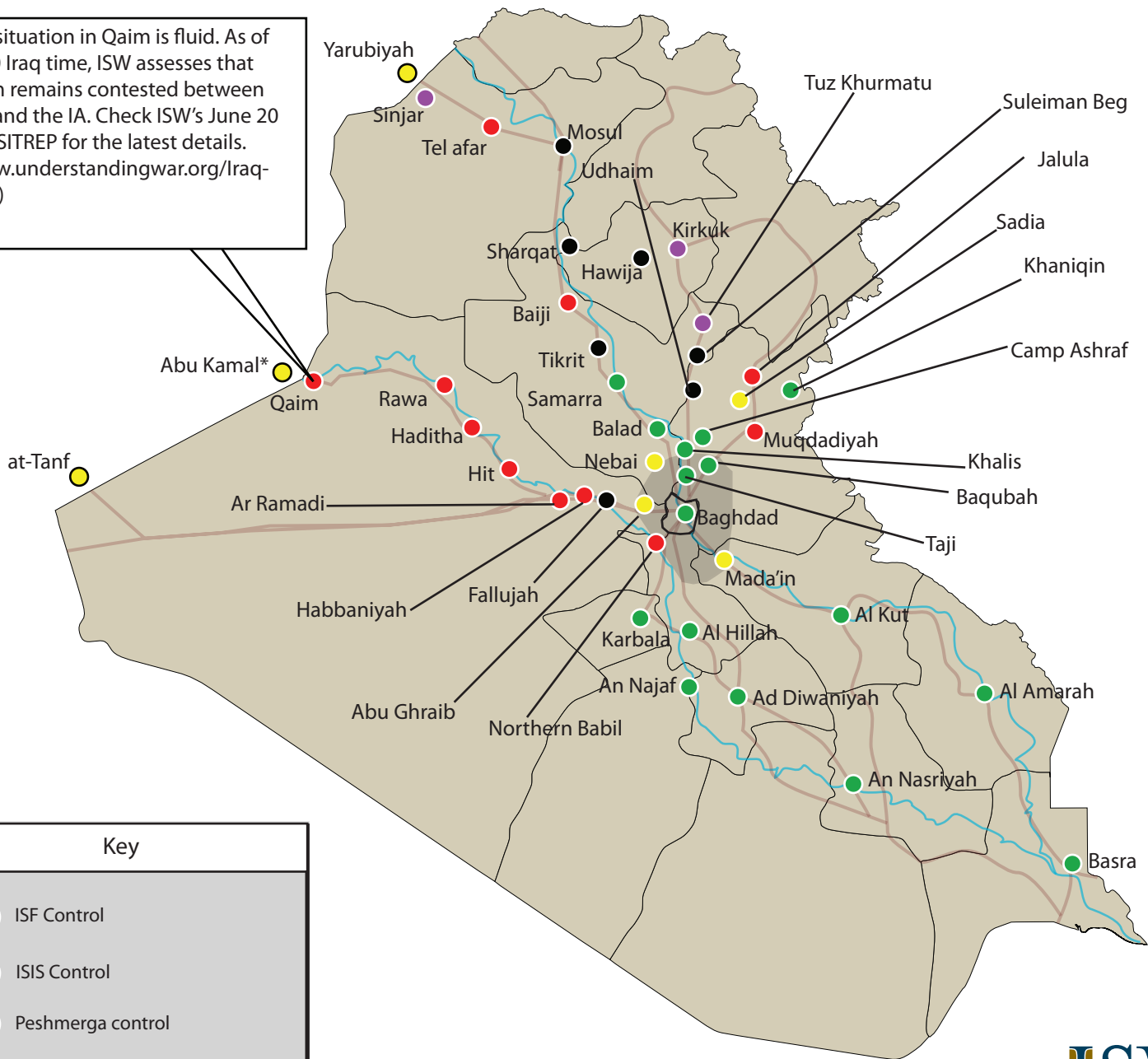


Control of Terrain in Iraq: June 20, 2014
