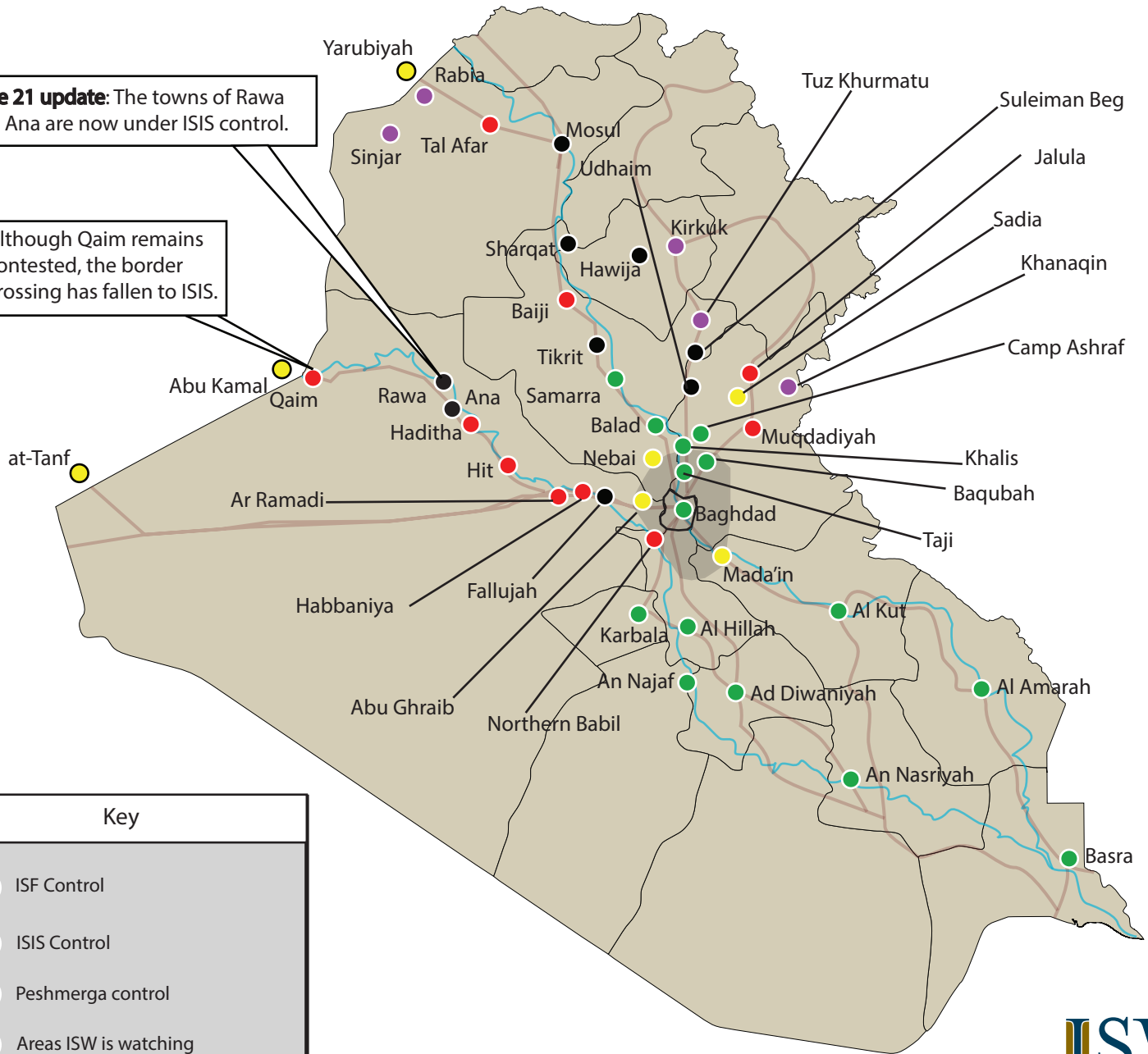


# Control of Terrain in Iraq: June 21, 2014

**June 21 update:** The towns of Rawa and Ana are now under ISIS control.

Although Qaim remains contested, the border crossing has fallen to ISIS.

Sunni insurgents and JRTN are also claiming offensives in the contested zones. Shi'a militias are active in Samarra, Diyala, and the southern Baghdad Belts. Abu Kamal, on the Syrian side of the border, has remained under Jabhat al-Nusra's control despite ISIS advances on Qaim in Iraq.

**Changes for June 21 update:** The towns of Rawa and Ana are under ISIS Control. Khanaqin, northeast of Baghdad, is now controlled by the Peshmerga.
