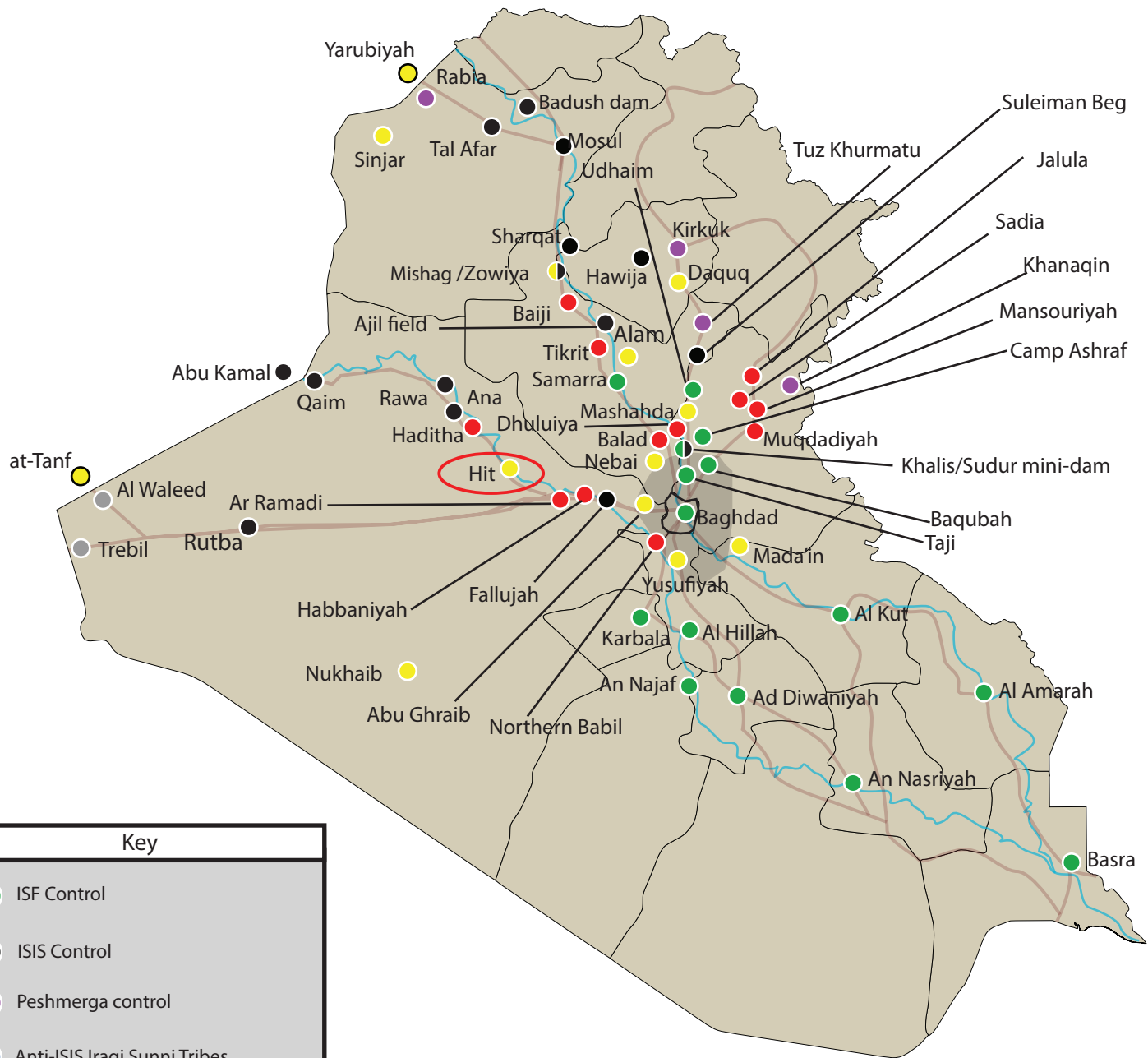


# Control of Terrain in Iraq: July 27, 2014

**Changes for July 27 update:** ISW is placing a watch on Hit as an area that ISIS likely desires to control. ISIS launched an attack on the Hit District from its southern entrance near the Albu Hamdan Bridge. The bridge was blocked by the ISF and tribes in order to prevent future attacks.
