
Control of Terrain in Iraq: August 13, 2014



Changes for August 13 update: The sub-district of Jalula was reported to be taken by ISIS after launching a major assault that pushed the Peshmerga out of the area. Jalula is therefore now depicted as ISIS-controlled. Also, ISIS reportedly set up defensive positions in the area while the Peshmerga deployed to the nearby Khaniqin, which prompted ISIS to target a bridge that connected the two areas in order to prevent a Peshmerga advance. The northern areas of Makhmour and Gwer were reportedly seized by the Peshmerga on August 10, 2014. Since then, there have been no major clashes, and the president of Iraqi Kurdistan reportedly visited Makhmour, Gwer, and Khazir. These areas are now depicted therefore as Peshmerga-controlled.
