
Syria Situation Report: December 15 - 22, 2016

1 December 19: Regime Holds Talks on Opposition Evacuation from Mount Hermon: 6 December 15 - 22: Opposition Evacuates Eastern Aleppo City: The Syrian Activists claimed that a regime delegation held two meetings with opposition representatives over the Arab Army announced its full control over Aleppo City on December 22 following the past week to discuss the evacuation of nearly 2,000 opposition fighters and their families from Mount end of evacuations from the remaining opposition-held districts of Eastern Aleppo Hermon in Southern Syria. Evacuees would reportedly be allowed to depart for Idlib Province. City. Opposition forces initially surrendered on December 13 following negotiations between Turkey and Russia. IS previously **Unification in Idlib Province Amidst Rumors of Ongoing** conducted an SVBIED attack at a border post near Rukban IDP Camp in June 2016 that killed at least seven soldiers. 'Grand Merger' Negotiations: Local affiliates of Jabhat Fatah a-Sham, Ahrar a-Sham, Faylaq a-Sham, and Thuwar a-Sham in Turmanin in Idlib Province announced their merger under a unified military body. The announcement comes amidst rumors of renewed negotiations for a 'grand merger' of Jabhat Fatah a-Sham, Ahrar a-Sham, and other factions in Northern Syria under the name of the Syrian Islamic Commission.
